Providence Reunion Activities

Newport

A 90 minute guided motorcoach tour of Newport. Free time to shop and have lunch on our own and then a tour of The Breakers Mansion

Tuesday, October 9th \$62

Newport boasts the largest number of original Colonial buildings of any city in the country. It is also famous for mansions built in the 1800's by the wealthy and used only in the summer months, hence the term "summer cottages". And, Newport's magnificent harbor draws boats from around the world, confirming its reputa-



tion as a sailing capital. See many sites in this beautiful and historic city on a driving tour. Then there will be free time for lunch (on your own) and shopping downtown in scenic Brick Marketplace and Bannister's Wharf. This afternoon enjoy an audio tour of the spectacular Breakers mansion. Built in 1895 for the Vanderbilt family, this 70-room estate was modeled after a northern Italian Renaissance palace.

BATTLESHIP COVE

featuring The USS Massachusetts and the Maritime Museum

Thursday, October 11th \$74

Battleship Cove, located in Fall River, Massachusetts, is home to our country's most complete collection of 20th century naval ships. Explore the USS Massachusetts, the World War II attack submarine Lionfish, the destroyer Joseph P. Kennedy, Jr., and PT Boats 617 and 796. The Hiddensee, a Soviet-built missile corvette, is the only one of its kind on exhibit in the world. After lunch on the USS Massachusetts visit the Maritime Museum.

Founded in 1968, the Museum is a historical and nautical museum representing the span of sea history, including the famous Fall River Line and RMS Titanic and houses more than 150 scale models, 30,000 photographs, videos, uniforms and a research library (by appointment only). The Maritime Museum is a vital key in connecting the maritime history of Fall River to the greater story of naval heritage. The main gallery exhibition entitled, Sails, Paddles & Screws: The History of Maritime Travel and Culture includes three distinct sections: 1.) Sail- which includes such topics as the Age of Exploration, the Portuguese experience, whaling, maritime folktales; 2.) Paddles- The Fall River Line, technological advances in sea travel, minorities and women and the sea; 3.) Screws- Ocean liners, RMS Titanic, United Fruit and other local imports, class and the sea, and warships.



Three hour guided motorcoach tour of the Rhode Island capitals most historic sites. Friday, October 12th \$38

Providence, the capital of Rhode Island, was a shipping and shipbuilding town in its early days. Historic Benefit Street is lined with fine examples of beautifully restored Colonial homes and nearby is the oldest First Baptist Church in America. On a tour of this Renaissance City, also see the magnificent Rhode Island State House, Brown University, the Rhode Island School of

Design and WaterPlace Park. Tour the John Brown House, described by John Quincy Adams as "the most magnificent and elegant mansion that I have ever seen on this continent." Attention to historical accuracy has made this three-story Georgian house, built in 1786, one of the finest historic houses in the country.
